- Contribution to the Club other than their ability as a player
- Involved in at least one Club activity
- Efforts have a positive effect on the club
- Volunteers on a regular basis
- Attempts to involve other members
- Supports club administrators
- Promotes the Club in a positive light
- Displays / encourages good sportsmanship
- Been a member for at least two years
- Must be a financial member

- Personal trophy, eg medallion, statuette, etc
- Exemption of club fees component of annual subs the following year
