Keys

The Board believes that there are many, many keys to our gates, and maybe to the clubrooms, out and about in our past and present members and non members hands. It would be good if we could retrieve some of these keys.

If any member has club keys in their possession that they no longer need please return them to the Secretary.

We have investigated changing the gate locks / keys but the cost of doing so runs into the several thousands.

Rose Green Carpet

Repairs to the Rose Green carpet were scheduled to commence on May 27. Upon inspection of our carpet the decision was taken to not proceed with the lift the whole carpet, repair the under surface, and replace the carpet scenario.

Our carpet is ageing and has had plenty of use over the years. The experts felt that they may not be able to restretch the carpet once the repairs had been completed. The carpet has lost its stretchability and may have torn upon being stretched. Some repairs were undertaken to a couple of the worst areas.

It was not worth the risk of losing the carpet now and having to replace it immediately.

The experts believe it has about 2 years of life after which the full replacement will be undertaken. In line with all of the above we have been advised to no longer dry vacuum the carpet. The Board have recently approved the purchase of a more powerful, robust blower, and this should be in use very soon.

Eftpos

We have recently installed an Eftpos machine in the bar. There has been a reasonable demand for this facility especially during the Victorian Open and when we have visitors at our club. The minimum purchase on the Eftpos is \$10 and the maximum cash out is \$50.

The machine will be available for members to pay their subs (only when the bar is open) and some members have taken advantage of this facility already.

Annual Subscriptions

Accounts for our annual subs. have recently been handed to, or posted to our members.

The decision was taken to increase our annual fee for affiliated members by \$10 to \$175. This increase was made to cover increasing costs, particularly costs passed onto us by the City of Greater Shepparton. These include large increases in insurance and water usage costs. Our building is also getting to an age where maintenance costs will increase. I believe this will be the first subscription increase for 4 years. The Board also made the decision to decrease the fee for Social members from \$50 to \$25 with no free first year.

Over the last few years we have signed up a lot of new social members as the first year was free. Once these members received an account for \$50 for the second year very, very few would remain as members.

We hope this change will encourage more Social members to remain with us, and convert to fully affiliated members in due course.

Sponsorship Manager

Keith Dudley has been good enough to take on the very important role of Sponsorship Manager.

Keith and Cathy are currently away on holidays, and once they return we will talk to Keith to see what ideas he has in this area.

Outdoor Shelters

The East Shepparton Bowls Club have been good enough to offer us a number of their shelters as they are no longer required by them. Their new undercover facility is about to be built, and, the shelters are in the way.

Once we retrieve the shelters we hope to instal them on the Western side of the Members Green to provide shelter, mainly for our Thursday Pairs Summer bowls. The Board are also hopeful of meeting with the East Shepparton management once their new facility is up and running.

We believe this could have substantial benefit to both of our clubs insofar as co-ordinating tournaments and club bowls days and trying to attract, and keep, more and bigger bowls events in the town.

We thank East Shepparton for their generosity.
