## **PENNANT BOWLS**

The GVBD have advised that pennant bowls will commence as follows:-

**Midweek Tuesday November 3**

**Weekend Saturday November 7**

There will be NO spare days allocated for rain or heat. Any games lost for those reasons will be treated as an abandoned game.

There will be a break of 10 (ten) minutes after the 14th end.

**NO** afternoon tea will be provided and it is suggested that players arrange their own eats.

Availability of Tea / Coffee to be arranged by the host club.

## **PRACTICE GAMES**

With the above in mind there will be intra club practice matches at Shepparton Park on October 24 & October 31.

It is not practicable or desirable to arrange practice games with other clubs when there is travel involved.

We are still seeking members to make up our pennant teams for the season.

Midweek Pennant numbers seem to be reasonable at this time.

Saturday Pennant requires 76 players every week. At the moment we have about that number.

As there are always people away for health, holidays or whatever more names are required.

## **MEMBERSHIP**

The majority of our members have paid their subs. for the upcoming season and we thank them very much. It is a very solid commitment to our club by members to pay their subs. without knowing what the bowls season would look like and whether there would be any bowls at all.

The GVBD are planning for a full 14 game season and all other events continuing.

With the above in mind we can advise that Bowls Victoria have reduced the affiliation fee paid by each member by 50%.

This means that each member who has paid their subs is entitled to a refund of \$35.50. The Board have discussed how we can refund that amount and decided that it will be by a reduction of that amount in next years subs. It would be a very messy process to give a cash refund now. It was also decided that any member who due to financial hardship would like a cash refund now can do so by personal approach to the Treasurer.

It is a great gesture by Bowls Victoria and we are sure that all members appreciate this.

## **UMPIRES**

Bowls Australia have advised that Laser Levels have now been approved for use in ALL levels of Bowls competition in Australia. There are 3 approved levels and the Bowls shop would be a good place to inquire.

Any umpire requiring a copy of the advice should see the Secretary.

## **COVID19**

After a very trying and disjointed 7 months we finally got some good news last week as far as bowls is concerned.

The bowls club is again open to bowls activities with pretty well unlimited numbers as far as the actual game is concerned.

The rules say you can “play bowls with the number of people required to play” plus coaches and umpires.

We are still limited to minimal numbers inside the club and we are allowed 50 people in the Plaza area, as long as they are seated.

We must continue to follow all of the rules, such as:-

1.5metre distancing

Face masks must be worn

Please enter your details in the attendance register

Do not handle other peoples bowls/equipment

Do not attend if you are unwell
