I just thought I would send the Board and club members an update on my situation at the moment. I had been struggling with my fitness for a few weeks prior to, and during, the Victorian Open and this came to a head on Monday the 5th. My left leg and foot were not operating very well and on that Monday morning I could not get up off the couch. My wife called David to come and help me and he quickly realised I had a problem. He immediately drove me to the emergency department where after a number of tests I was diagnosed with a stroke. It was later revealed that I may have suffered 2 or 3 slight strokes.

I spent the night in the emergency department before being moved to the general ward where I spent a further 3 nights. I came home last Thursday but had to return to emergency on Friday due to an elevated heart rate. This was sorted after a day of tests and I returned home on late Friday. I am presently relaxing on the couch, feeling well and I have had no pain throughout. I realise I have a long road ahead of me and I'm not sure when, or if, I will able to play again.

GV Health, and their staff have been exemplary in their treatment of me, I could not fault them. I would especially like to thank David with his wonderful medical knowledge and assistance to me over the whole time. A huge thanks to our members for their many messages and phone calls. It is greatly appreciated. Thank you to Marg Stibbard for her dedicated work in the bar, to Ray, Kelvin and all others who stepped up to help out in the bar.

I hope to get over to the club in the near future to watch a few bowls go down.
