CLUB MATTERS

I have quite a lot of information to relay to members following our recent CGMBR delegates meeting and our club board meeting.

The CGMBR:

Heat issues at Colbinabbin Division 6 North Weekend pennant match. We wrote to CGM regarding the safety issue of this game continuing during extreme heat. We received a terse reply from Colbinabbin that they had followed the rules. Several of our bowlers had become distressed by the heat and play should have stopped. We have bureau records showing that the temperature from 12 noon onwards was 42 degrees. We will not be taking this matter further.

There was also an issue with the clothing worn by some of our ladies at representative matches. The person in question has been informed that they were incorrect. The CGMBR will send a survey to all clubs over several matters:

- 1. The format of pennant next season. This will consider the number of ends for pennant and the composition of teams.
- 2. Whether, or not, afternoon teas will resume next season.

3. A change to temperatures under the heat rule. We will most likely call a meeting of all members to discuss these important matters.

Lists have been put on the outside notice boards for players to indicate whether they will be playing pennant next season.

We realise this is very early but we do need to get an indication of our numbers for next season. We are required to provide this information earlier each year to enable the CGMBR to complete draws and get their booklet printed.. We had an influx of about 25 new members and entered teams assuming that we would have ample players to fill them all. As always not everyone wants to play pennant and have that commitment, ill health may preclude playing, etc.

It is most important that we get this as near as possible to perfect, as, if not, players may miss out on games, or, we are always short and may have to withdraw teams. It is a very difficult job for selectors to be trying to find players to fill positions.

We thank all of those who stepped up this year when asked.

The Bowls committee AGM will be held in late April. Nominations for all of the various positions will open as soon as the pennant season finishes. Nomination forms will be out at that time.

Please give serious consideration to putting your names forward to help with the running of your club. We always need new blood with new ideas and enthusiasm. The club does not work without our hard working volunteers giving their time to the club.
