Kevin Hicks Sponsorship

As part of the sponsorship agreement with Kevin Hicks Real Estate, there is an opportunity for our club to gain additional funding. Put simply, if the club refers a client to Kevin Hicks, and they proceed to make a sale, the club receives a cash bonus.

The system works like this;

- 1. A member (or family or friend) notifies the club that they intend to sell their property.
- 2. The club provides the name to Kevin Hicks RE who then contacts the interested person.
- 3. If Kevin Hicks RE arranges a sale, the club receives a cash bonus.

There is no compulsion to use Kevin Hicks to sell the property, they are simply asking for the opportunity to provide a quotation which you may either accept or reject.

The only stipulation is that the club must make the referral. If you go directly to Kevin Hicks RE and say you are a club member, the additional funding is not available.
