Umpires

Rose Green heaters

We have made inquiries regarding lowering the heaters to make them more effective.

The heaters can be lowered, however, if they were they would require a protective safety mesh cover at a cost of \$2,000 per heater = \$12,000. The heaters could be replaced with newer ones but these cost \$3,600 each. = \$21,600.

The manufacturer of our heaters has advised that lowering the heaters does not necessarily provide a better result as far as heat output. It seems all bowlers will need to continue to rug up during the Winter.

Drought Assistance

The Thursday men's pairs organisers have a "Policeman's Hat" to collect fines for misdemeanours such as wrong bias, etc.

The proceeds were regularly donated to GV Hospice Care. The decision was recently taken to donate the funds to Drought assistance, and subsequently a cheque for \$352 has been forwarded to The Rotary Club drought fund. * The Club Opening day, in conjunction with RSL, was a great success with 84 bowlers attending. A great afternoon tea was enjoyed by all.

* The Board have approved a quote from Norvec to get the electrics in the BBQ area improved. Last year the power was overloaded and was off for some time.

* The Board also approved the purchase of a new lawn mower, as one of the old ones has worn out.

* We are also looking into obtaining a new achievement board for the North wall inside the clubhouse. The old one is full with all the wonderful feats of our members.

Victorian Open

With the Open approaching very quickly rosters will be prepared in the near future. We need every hand on deck to help with this huge event, including on the BBQ, Bar (RSA certificate required) greens and surrounds. There will also be the usual bowls jobs such as Markers, Scoreboard Attendants. Many hands are required to set up and then clean up at the conclusion of the Open.

The Open is from 16—23 November. Please mark these dates in your diaries and consider helping wherever possible.

Smoking

We remind all members that all areas inside our perimeter fences are “**No smoking**” and receptacles are provided outside the gates. We appreciate that our members do obey these regulations, but occasionally visitors require a reminder.

Club Event Information

Dress code : Dress code for Club Championship events will be casual up to but not including the Grand Final unless otherwise requested by the Match Committee.

Green : Matches to be played on mutually acceptable green / rink, unless directed by the Match Committee. If players can't agree, decide by toss of coin.

Results : The result of each match is to be entered as soon as possible after the match has been played.

Handicaps : These are currently being reviewed and changed to fit in with Bowls Victoria guidelines. Some members may notice quite a change from previous years.

Entry fee : The entry fee for these events is \$7 per player per event. This should be paid on entry, or at the time the first round match is played. Please enclose the money in an envelope with your name and event being entered clearly written on the envelope.

Rounds : The date for the completion of each round is indicated on the draw sheet. Failure to comply with these dates (without approval from the Match Committee) may result in both players being disqualified.
