

Club Events 2025 / 2026 - Conditions of Play

- ❖ By entering club events you agree to adhere to timelines and rulings as determined by the Match Committee.
- ❖ If players can't agree when to play a match, approach the Match Committee who will set the date and time for the match to be played.
- ❖ It is good bowls etiquette that you do not practice on the green the same day you will be playing your match on later that day.

Rounds : The date for the completion of each round is indicated on the draw sheet and in the club booklet. Failure to comply with these dates (without approval from the Match Committee) may result in both players being disqualified.

Entry fee : The entry fee for these events is \$10 per player per event. This should be paid when playing the first game of the event. Please enclose the money in the envelope provided near the outside notice boards and complete all details. Both players are to include their entry fee in the same envelope.

Green : Matches to be played on mutually acceptable green / rink, unless directed by the Match Committee. If players can't agree, decide by toss of coin.

Results : The result of each match is to be entered on the draw sheet as soon as possible after the match has been played.

Handicaps : These are reviewed annually to fit in with Bowls Victoria guidelines.

Dress code : Dress code for Club Championship events will be casual up to but not including the Grand Final unless otherwise requested by the Match Committee.

Committee: The Match Committee reserves the right to alter these conditions as they see fit.

A Grade	- 25 up - open to all affiliated bowlers	1/10/25
B Grade	- 25 up - open to all affiliated bowlers with handicap of 6 or less - bowlers who have previously won a B Grade Championship at any time are ineligible to enter, including at another club	1/10/25
Pairs	Ladies' and Men's - open to all affiliated bowlers - preliminary rounds 15 ends - final 18 ends - format is 2x2x2x2 Mixed – all games 15 ends	1/10/25 Ladies' & Men's Pairs 14/12/25 Mixed Pairs
100 Up	- handicap must be played off	14/12/25
21 Up	- handicap must be played off	14/12/25
Ladies Drawn Pairs	- 3 bowl pairs - 3 games of 10 ends - played on set date and time as indicated in the booklet / draw sheet	14/12/25
Mixed Drawn Canadian Pairs	- all games 15 ends - format is 2x4x2 - a handicap event, players handicaps are averaged to ascertain team handicap - played on set dates and times as indicated in the booklet / draw sheet - if a substitute is used, the team handicap will be adjusted for that match	1/3/26
Men's Drawn Triples	- all games 15 ends - 3 bowl triples format - played on set dates and times as indicated in the booklet / draw sheet	1/3/26
